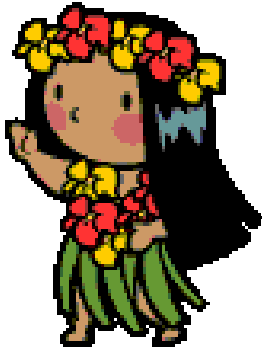
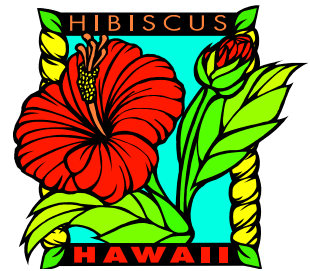

The Aloha Dance will take place on Friday, April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2019, from 8:00pm – 11:00pm. Each ticket is \$8. Tickets are now on sale through Wednesday, April 10<sup>th</sup>. Tickets will not be sold at the door. Faculty members and an administrator will be present to chaperone this event.

All students must follow the guidelines and dress code stated below. Each student must turn in a permission form at the time of purchasing their ticket.

Aloha Dance Guidelines:

1. Students will not be allowed in and out of the dance.
2. Students will be dismissed from the dance at 11:00 pm.
3. Tickets are nonrefundable.
4. Only students in good standing will be allowed to purchase a ticket.
5. Dress attire for the event is Hawaiian Luau style. The dress code for the event will be enforced. All outfits must remain intact for the entire event.

Dress Code:

Acceptable for HER:

- Colorful Summer/Spring dresses
- Capri or shorts to the knees
- Sandals
- Hawaiian knee length Skirts with a nice top
- Light make-up
- No spaghetti strap or strapless tops

Acceptable for HIM:

- Hawaiian shirts/surfer type t-shirts
- Shorts or Jeans
- Sneakers/shoes, sandals
- Light colored Polo shirts

Should you have any doubt about your attire, please be sure to ask an administrator prior to the dance. Be aware that Mother of Our Redeemer reserves the right to prohibit the admittance of any student improperly dressed.
